Read and write numbers up to 20

Order and compare numbers to 20

Use whole numbers to count up to 20 items, including zero

Add numbers which total up to 20

Subtract numbers from numbers up to 20

Recognise and interpret the symbols +, – and = appropriately

Recognise coins and notes and write them in numbers with the correct symbols (£ & p), where these involve numbers up to 20

Read 12-hour digital and analogue clocks in hours

Know the number of days in a week, months and seasons in a year

Be able to name and sequence the days of the weeks, months of the year and the seasons

Describe and make comparisons in words between measures of items including size, length, width, height

Describe and make comparisons in words between measures of weight

Describe and make comparisons in words between measures of capacity

Identify and recognise common 2-D shapes

Identify and recognise common 3-D shapes

Use every day positional vocabulary to describe position and direction, including left, right, in front, behind, under and above

Read numerical information from lists

Sort and classify objects using a single criterion

Records information in a simple chart or table

Use appropriate methods to produce, check and present results that make sense
