Read, write, order and compare numbers up to 100

Count reliably up to 50 items

Add numbers which total up to 50

Subtract numbers from numbers up to 50

Recall and use number facts for the 2, 5 and 10 times table

Divide by sharing or grouping

Recognise coins and notes and start to add small amounts of money

Read 12-hour digital and analogue clocks in half hours

Draw the hands on a clock face to show the times to the hour and half past

Know the number of minutes in an hour and the number of hours in a day

Starts to measure and records lengths, heights, mass/weight, capacity and volume

Sorts 2D shapes and compares similarities and differences

Sorts 3D shapes and compares similarities and differences

Use positional language to describe where objects are in relation to others

Answers questions based on simple charts and tables

Sort and classify objects using two criteria

Read simple charts and diagrams, including a tally chart, block diagram/graph

Draw simple charts and diagrams, including a tally chart, block diagram/graph

Use given mathematical information and recognise and use simple mathematical terms appropriate to Entry Level 1

Provide a simple explanation for results.
