



# Maths 4

Count, read and write numbers up to 1000

Order and compare numbers up to 1000

Add and subtract using three-digit whole numbers

Multiply two-digit whole numbers by single whole numbers

Divide three-digit whole numbers by single whole numbers and express remainders

Approximate by rounding to the nearest 100, and use this rounded answer to check results

Recognise, find and write simple fractions of amounts of objects

Read, write and use decimals to two decimal places

Find different combinations of coins that equal the same amounts of money

Solve simple addition and subtraction problems with money including giving change

Read and record time in common date formats

Read times displayed on analogue clocks to the nearest five minutes

Record metric measures of length, including millimetres, centimetres, metres and kilometres

Record measures of weight, including grams and kilograms

Record measures of capacity, including millilitres and litres

Read and use simple scales to the nearest labelled division

Read and compare positive temperatures

Describe the properties of common 2-D and 3-D shapes, including numbers of sides, corners, edges, faces, angles and base

Gives positional language for someone else to follow

Make numerical comparisons from bar charts

Presents discrete and continuous data using appropriate graphical methods

Take information from one format and represent the information in another format, including use of bar charts

Recognise, understand and use simple mathematical terms appropriate to Entry Level 2

Present appropriate explanations using numbers, measures, simple diagrams, simple charts and symbols appropriate to Entry Level 2.
