



Introduction to Maths B

Read and write numbers up to 5
Order and compare numbers to 5
Recite numbers in order to 10
Count reliably to 5 and make sets of 5 objects
Add numbers which total up to 5
Subtract numbers from numbers up to 5
Find one more or one less from a small group of objects
In practical situations can respond to add more and take some away
Sort a pile of coins by size
Show an awareness of time, through some familiarity with significant times of the day
Know some of the names for the days of the week and months of the year
Use words to compare sizes and quantities such as heavy or light, full or empty, long or short
Recognise shapes are the same or different
Select a particular named shape
Understand and can demonstrate forwards, backwards and sideways
Sort objects by a given criteria such as red or blue
Know that information can be displayed on a chart
Explain where simple information should go on a prepared table or chart
Creates own simple representations of a problem
Respond appropriately to key vocabulary and questions
Begin to use key Mathematical vocabulary
