



# Introduction to Maths C

Read and write numbers up to 10

Order and compare numbers to 10

Count on past 10

Count out up to 10 objects from a group

Add numbers which total up to 10

Subtract numbers from numbers up to 10

In practical activities and discussion, begin to use the vocabulary associated with addition and subtraction

Sort a pile of coins into groups of the same

Sequence events of the day in chronological order using language such as before and after, next, first, today, yesterday, tomorrow, morning, afternoon and evening

Shows an awareness of time, through some familiarity with significant times of the day

Know the names for days of the week

Know the names for the months of the year and the seasons

Orders two or three objects by length or height

Orders two or three objects by weight

Orders two or three objects by capacity

Recognise some common 2-D shapes

Recognise some common 3-D shapes

Explores the position of objects and shows understanding of words signs and symbols that describe positions

Can recognise information on a prepared chart like days of the week

When sorting can say why an object cannot go in a group

Sort objects using their own choice of chart or diagram

Record simple information in a prepared table or chart

Use Mathematical vocabulary appropriate for this level

Record using marks that they can interpret and explain

Uses talk to connect ideas and describe what is happening
