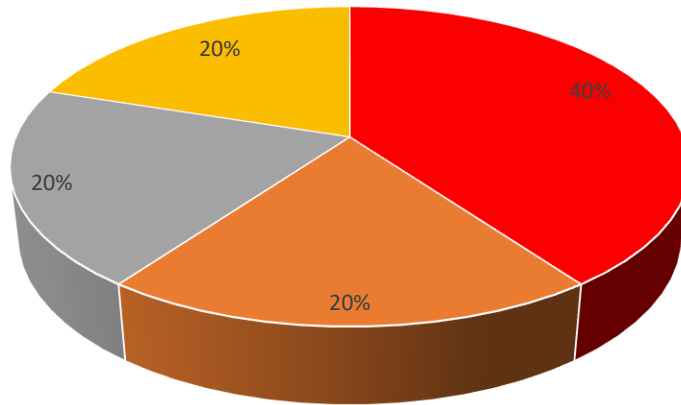


Results, Outcomes and Destinations 2021/22

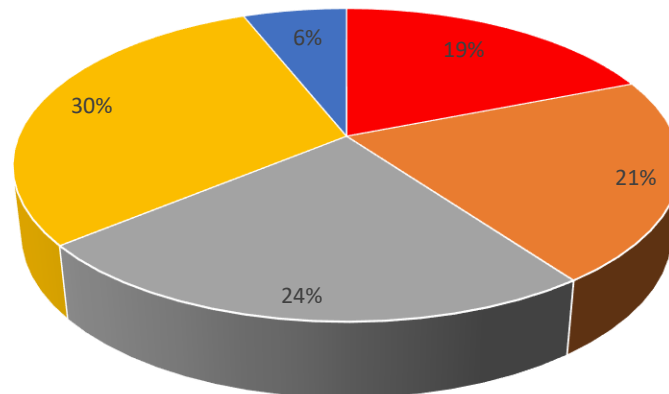
Graphics and notes below illustrate the results and outcomes of our Year 11 students 2021/22.

Highlights (Head of English)

- Two students this year have achieved Functional Skills Level 1 in English. This is the equivalent to a GCSE grade 1 – 3. Both students will progress onto their preferred courses at college quicker due to their English qualification obtained at The Valley.
- 10% increase in students obtaining an Entry Level 3 English qualification, compared to last year.
- Slight increases in both Entry Level 1 and 2 qualifications obtained.
- 21% decrease in students that left without a complete English accreditation.

Context:

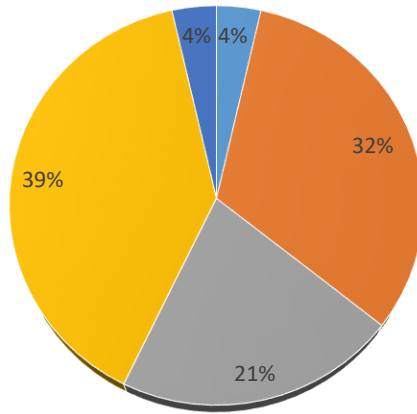
I am particularly proud of this set of results for two reasons. Firstly, the autumn term was disrupted severely by Covid and most students spent several weeks learning remotely. During this time, I did contract Covid and therefore was unable to interact and deliver learning to my groups due to being unwell. This period of time was disruptive and did set us back in our learning journey. However, once students were back in the school, they were brilliant in getting back into their studies and most remained motivated and focused until the summer term.

Secondly, I was new to the school in September. I did not teach this cohort in year 10. Unfortunately, the accreditation process was not started with this cohort in year 10. Nevertheless, they have worked incredibly hard and I am very proud that 81% of our year 11 students are leaving The Valley with a full accreditation in English at least at Entry Level 1. This compares to 60% in the previous year.

Next steps:

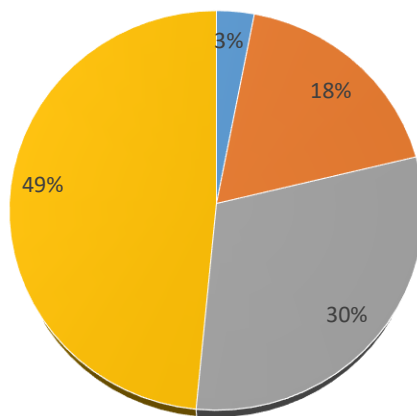
Currently, accreditation is underway for our current year 10 cohort. 50% of the year group have already passed their Entry Level 1 English. Most of these students will have the opportunity to sit their Entry Level 2 exams this academic year, which means when they start year 11 it will be with Functional Skills Level 1 in sight.

Maths Summary (Head of Maths)

Highlights:

- Only one student left The Valley School without gaining an accreditation and he had relocated before he was able to take the exam, but otherwise would have passed at Entry level 1.
- There was a 9% increase in students obtaining an Entry Level 2 Maths qualification, compared to last year.
- There was a 9% increase in students obtaining an Entry Level 3 Maths qualification, compared to last year.
- Although we did not have anyone gaining a Functional skills Level One this year we did have 5 students working at this level. They were unsuccessful in the exam because they were not yet independently recalling all the Maths components that they needed to use to answer questions at this level. They will however be able to build on this knowledge at college.

Context:

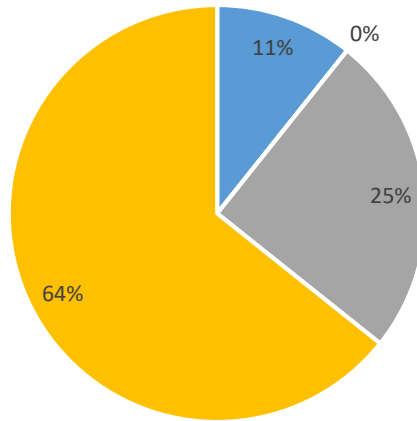
The autumn term was severely disrupted by Covid and most students spent several weeks learning remotely, disrupting their progress and setting them back on the Learning Journey. The resilience the students showed to get their learning back on track was exceptional but it still took a while for students to recall previously secured skills and develop the confidence to use these independently.

I am very proud of the fact that 97% of Year 11 students left The Valley with an accreditation and that more students gained Entry level accreditations at a higher level.

Next steps:

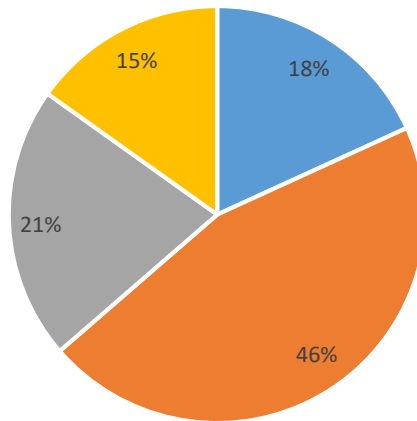
Accreditation is underway for our current Year 10 cohort. 53% of the year group have already passed their Entry Level 1 Maths, 21% their Entry 2 Maths and 6% Entry Level 3. They will be able to build on from these qualifications as they move into Year 11.

Science Summary 2022 (Head of Science)

Highlights:

- All students who gained an entry level 3 did so by attending extra Science sessions often during their social times.

- All students who were entered gained the maximum marks for the “can do tasks” and higher than predicted marks for their practical task.

Context:

Our current OCR science entry level is assessed by short tests, can do tasks and a written practical. Study begins in year 9. The current cohort did not complete any assessments during year 9 and did not complete tests during year 10. To reflect disruption caused by Covid OCR reduced the number assessments that needed to be submitted however only students who were willing to work with staff during their social time completed the full number of tests.

Next steps:

The current year 10 are completing as many assessments as possible before Ms Richman leaves at the end of term. Other Science entry levels require less assessments but the assessments are of poor quality.

For example Pearson’s require 6 tests and no practical work. The tests have confusing wording and few illustrations. However we are looking into whether students can sit these tests and before the entry date and be entered for the qualification they have gained the best result in.

Comparisons show increased number of entries and higher attainment in English and Maths.

Students were entered for lower level qualifications in Science. With a change of staff we have higher expectations of our Science students in 2022/23.

On the data sheet below, green means the students met the prediction, yellow they are above and red below.

English and PEs results were particularly pleasing with many students exceeding expectations.
