We are exploring opportunities to let our facilities to create another funding stream for the school.

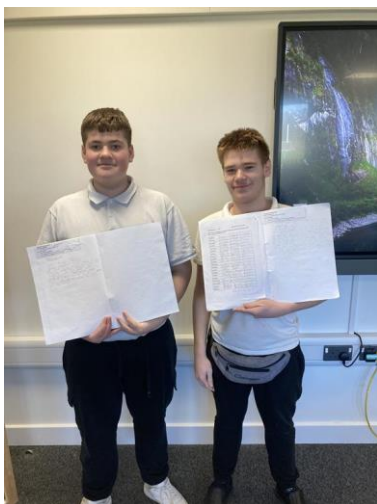
